#### Mission


AISS aims to support high-achieving, economically disadvantaged high school students interested in STEM careers. The 2year program, starting in junior year, includes workshops and field trips to help students build careers in STEM and break the cycle of poverty.

#### Problem


Event scheduling for the program was managed on a Google Sheet, leading to issues with event detail accuracy, schedule reorganization, and tracking event statistics for potential sponsors. This outdated method also hindered program expansion, as it was difficult to manage the increasing number of scheduled events.

#### Solution


A schedule planner application to help AISS admin easily organize and plan events. Admins can block out each day with events, such as guest speakers and STEM-based workshops, and source events from a catalog of previous events. This new system is projected to add an additional quarter of events and expand the number of scholars accepted into the program.

#### **Mission**


Feeding Pets of the Homeless believes in the healing power of companion pets and of the human/animal bond. Their task, nationwide, is to feed and provide basic emergency veterinary care to their pets and thus relieve the anguish and anxiety of homeless guardians who cannot provide for them.

#### Problem

The entire process of onboarding and the donation reporting process requires constant back-and-forth communication that was not intuitive. Additionally, receiving donation reports was difficult without a streamlined process and the sites could not view the donations and the impact they were making.

#### Solution

A new website that expedites the onboarding and donation reporting processes for donation sites. This platform will serve as a central hub where donation sites can register themselves, submit their donation sheets, have quick communication, track their contributions, and allow FPH to monitor all of these interactions.


Stand Up to Trash helps protect and conserve the ocean by raising awareness of the negative effects caused by plastic pollution through environmental education for future generations.




### Problem

# Solution




Get Inspired promotes ocean restoration education and engages the community in environmental stewardship. They offer volunteer opportunities to restore and preserve marine ecosystems and educate students on marine life by partnering with schools to restore kelp forests and Pismo clams in Orange County beaches.

# Problem

During their visits to OC beaches, the team at Get Inspired conducts surveys to collect data on Pismo clams. Currently, the data is recorded on paper and then manually entered into a spreadsheet and then imported into RStudio for analysis. However, this manual data entry process is inefficient and prone to errors and redundancy.

# Solution

We created a web application that facilitates tracking and managing Pismo clam data. The website hosts a database that stores details about Pismo clams. The interface allows the team to input, view, manage, and query clam data. The data can be exported to a CSV file to be used in RStudio.




#### Problem


Cell Dogs relies on Excel to store information on dogs and inmates in their program, including names, graduation status, jail location, and personal details. However, the increasing number of dogs and data has made using a basic Excel spreadsheet unmanageable for program managers.

#### Solution

We developed a web application to streamline data management. This tool enables Cell Dogs to easily create, update, delete, and access information, allowing for efficient planning based on dog distribution across jails. This internal database tool accelerates the relocation process, ultimately aiming to reduce the rate of repeat offenders and contribute to a decline in criminal behavior recurrence.





# Mission



#### Mission


OCH's mission is to provide a public service for the many habitats of Orange County through conservation efforts, volunteerism, education, and monitoring to promote the preservation, conservation, and restoration of natural habitats and the species therein.

### Problem

OC Habitats receives a high volume of mostly unstructured data from dozens of volunteer habitat surveyors. This data needs to be accurately aggregated and analyzed for usage by other NGOs and conservation entities. They experience data cleaning issues that stem from an inefficient data collection method.

# Solution

We designed and developed an online custom survey log management system that streamlines the data collection process while providing volunteers with a user-friendly interface. This system allows OCH's small staff to spend less time cleaning data and redirect that time towards conservation, restoration, and education efforts.







#### Solution

We created a system that digitizes the assessments to allow for a more efficient workflow. so student data is available sooner for advanced analysis and progress check-in. This system also allows TLP Admins to manage the schools and school districts in which their programs run to organize student data.



#### Solution




Waymakers' mission is to build safer communities by helping individuals make their way through conflict and crisis to a place of strength and stability.


#### Problem
